Programs include: Tee Ball for 5 year olds and first year 6 year olds (Co-Ed), Single A (Instructional for ages 6-7), Double A (developmental for ages 8-9, Triple A (ages 9-11), Major League (top players, ages 10-12) and Junior League (competitive program, ages 13-14) Please see website for further explanations.**SOFTBALL:** All children attaining ages 6-15 as of December 31st, 2009, are eligible. Programs include: Single A (instructional for ages 6-8, six year olds must have played one year in either Tee Ball or with another league), Double A (developmental for ages 8-9), Triple A (advanced for ages 9-11), Major League (top players, ages 10-12), Senior League (competitive program, ages 13-15, offered only with sufficient participation)**2010 SPRING SEASON SCHEDULE**

Practices:	Begin as early as March 1st. Days & times to be set by Managers
Games:	April 5th through June 15th, varying by League play level
All-Stars:	Team selection and practices begin June 15th, with tournament play through August 15th, depending upon the age of the player and advancement of the team.

Tryouts help determine League play level according to players' ability, therefore we require baseball players who will be age 9 or older as of April 30th, 2010, or softball players who will be age 9 or older as of December 31st, 2009, to attend tryouts. Players 9 years and older must attend at least one tryout session to be eligible to play at any level. Returning Majors players must attend a tryout. During tryouts players will be tested on catching, throwing, running & hitting skills. (See website for division level descriptions for specific skills at each level)

- **FOLLOWING TRYOUTS:** AAA, Majors & Junior Baseball, AAA Softball & Majors Softball are all filled via draft. Remaining players are placed on teams at appropriate levels.
- Due to safety issues, 11-14 year olds that miss baseball tryouts will not be able to be placed on a Majors or Juniors team. In order that they receive the fairest evaluation possible, it is strongly recommended that players tryout with their age group.
